ACTION TAKEN <p>On Feb. 1, 2012, I was assigned to follow up on the attached report of five (5) chain saws that were reported missing or stolen from the Service Yard at the Houdaille Quarry, Springfield. I contacted Mike Brennan, Division Head, Park Maintenance, who reported the incident yesterday, see attached IR submitted by Patrol, to confirm if the chain saws were still missing, as equipment is misplaced or sent out for maintenance, often without notification to Area Supervisors. Brennan stated that he was contacted by Will Borders, Area Supervisor of the Quarry, who informed him that two (2) of the missing chain saws were returned by employees who had borrowed them without his knowledge. Brennan was unaware of the names of the employees but was able to provide me with the following serial numbers for the returned saws; 1) model MS 441, SER# 170054300 and 2) model MS 460, SER# 166141591. Brennan could not provide any further information and suggested I speak to Borders for further information. Contact was made with Borders and a meeting was scheduled for the following day.</p> <p>I recommend that this investigation remain ACTIVE / INVEST.</p>

15. ACTION TAKEN

On Feb. 2, 2012, I met with Will Borders, Area Foreman, Quarry, regarding the missing chain saws and return of two (2) of them. Borders stated that prior to the end of the day on Jan. 31, 2012, Borders met with his workers and advised that the County Police had been there to take a report of missing chain saws. He further informed his workers that if any of them had borrowed, misplaced or sent any equipment for repair, especially chain saws, they should tell him. Borders continued to state that at the start of work on Feb. 1, 2012, two (2) of his employees had returned two (2) chain saws, stating that they had borrowed them to do work at their houses, without gaining permission or letting any supervisors know. Borders identified these workers as Paul Devito and Patrick Scanlon. Borders further stated that he checked the serial numbers against the ones reported missing and found them to match two (2) of them, notifying Brennan of the return, but not the employees involved. Borders further stated that the other three chain saws, all Stihl Brands, were approx. 5 to 6 years old and in poor condition, just as the two that had been returned.

I inquired as to if it is a practice for employees to use County equipment for personal use and he stated that it happens at times, but only small equipment and with express permission of the Supervisor. I cautioned Borders on this practice, as equipment could be considered stolen or missing. Borders agreed and further stated that there are times that equipment is sent for repair, again NOT being accounted for, making it appear that it is stolen or missing as well. Borders stated that he will look into creating and implementing a system, accounting for the smaller equipment. He will also continue searching for the three missing chain saws, checking the various County repair shops and other Service Yards, as they may have been borrowed or picked up by another crew. He was advised to contact me if he recovers any of the other missing chain saws. I also recommended he conduct a full inventory of his smaller hand held equipment to determine if any other items are missing, which he agreed to do. I also recommended this action to Brennan as well, for the other Service Yards, as it may lead to the recovery of these missing items and / or the uncovering of other missing or possible stolen items, which he agreed to complete.

I then contacted Union Detective Bureau & Elizabeth Detective Bureau, inquiring if they had any recent transactions involving chain saws [REDACTED]. Both of these Detective Bureau's maintain [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Conrad further stated that the listed seller of the chain saw was a subject named Patrick Scanlon, he provided the listed NJ Drivers License Number, as well as the listed address and date of birth. A check of the DL # found that it matched the information given and that it also matched the information of Quarry employee Patrick Scanlon. A copy of the purchase paperwork was faxed to me and it was found that the item purchased was a Stihl chain saw, 24" blade MS 460, with Ser.# 11289673503a-s and that Scanlon was paid \$120.00. I checked this Ser # against the remaining missing chain saws and found that it did not match any of the reported...

missing ones, however the Model and brand were the same as two of the three still unaccounted for.

Lt. Keating, who was also investigating this incident with me, responded to [REDACTED], to confirm the serial number listed was the actual number on the physical chain saw. Keating advised me that the chain saw had been sold, approx. a week or two earlier and that there was no information on the purchaser of the saw. Therefore, we are unable to physically check the saws actual serial number and are unable to confirm if it is one of the missing ones.

It was determined that Scanlon would be contacted and an interview conducted relating to his knowledge of the missing chain saws [REDACTED]

The Transaction Form is attached for review and I recommend that this case remain ACTIVE / INVEST.

On Feb. 6, 2012, Patrick Scanlon responded to Union County Police HQ to be interviewed regarding this current and active investigation. Due to the value of the missing items, this possible theft / missing equipment was considered a Disorderly Persons Offense and the interview was not video or audio recorded.

Upon Scanlon's arrival, background and pedigree information was obtained from Scanlon and he was interviewed regarding the chain saw he had returned and the surroundings regarding that incident. He admitted that he had borrowed the saw, without permission or any knowledge of Will Borders, so that he could cut some logs at a friends house. He further stated that after Borders addressed the staff, he returned the saw the next day, apologizing and taking full responsibility for using the saw without permission. Scanlon stated that Borders informed him that he may be subjected to disciplinary actions, as he was not allowed to use the saw without approval from him, Scanlon stated that he understood and accepted the consequences for his actions.

I then advised Scanlon of his Miranda Rights, as this is a criminal investigation, which may result in criminal charges. Scanlon read the Miranda Rights sheet, indicating that he understood each Right, both verbally and by placing his initials on the appropriate line. After reading the Waiver of Rights notice, Scanlon stated that he wanted to speak to his Attorney before answering any questions or discussing his employment, as he may be disciplined relating to his unapproved outside use of the returned saw. Scanlon further stated that he is currently involved in [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Scanlon also stated that he has decided to resign from his position with Union County, as he is going to be working for the Port of New York / New Jersey as a laborer. This new job provides him with greater pay, better insurance and a more flexible schedule as he has [REDACTED]

The interview was completed and Scanlon was provided with my contact information and I advised him to have his Attorney contact me to arrange for a follow up interview relating to this on going investigation. The Miranda Rights Form is attached for review.

I recommend that this case remain ACTIVE / INVEST.

<p>On this date, I contacted the Stihl company in an attempt to gain any further information on the chain saw serial number listed [REDACTED]. I spoke to a representative from the Technical Services Department who provided me with the following information regarding the listed serial number.</p> <p>The serial number that was written on the receipt is "S/N 11289673503A-S" and is the only number that was recorded by [REDACTED]. According to Stihl, this is NOT an accurate serial number for any of their chain saw products. This is actually a number that is used to represent the model of the unit and a part number. The representative broke down the number for me, stating that the first four (4) numbers, "1128" identify the model of the saw, in this case it is either a Magnum 460 or Magnum 46, depending on the age of the saw. The remaining numbers indicated a part identification on the saw, which he was unable to identify, not knowing where on the saw this number was stamped. He further stated that this group of numbers could be stamped on a number of locations on the saw and could have been confused for the actually serial number.</p> <p>The actual serial number would be stamped on the exhaust area, near the lock bar control, on the bottom of the engine block. He also added that the serial number would be nine (9) digits, starting with a 1 or 2, which would indicate what country it was manufactured in. The remaining set of numbers would also tell the type, style, engine size and year of manufacture. The representative further added that the Company may or may not be able to tell, ultimately, who the saw was sold to, as they often have saws that are sold in lots to a vendor, who then resells them to smaller retail locations and the serial numbers are only listed as being sold to the larger vendor and they are unaware of the vendors policies of serial number recordings. However, if the warranty for the saw was registered, they may have that information.</p> <p>I recommend that this case remain ACTIVE / INVEST.</p>
